

# Integration of cab label printers in SAP® systems

SAPscript currently has no printer drivers available for label printers. In the following we tell you how to print labels out of SAP® on cab devices and systems yet.

## **SAPscript**

 Method 1: Integration of cab JScript in a SAPscript form. Device type is LB\_CAB, "passing through" the data from the SAPscript form.

SAPscript incl. JScript → device type LB\_CAB → spool administration → cab label printer

 Method 2: Device type SWIN/SAPWIN in connection with SAPSprint and Windows driver

SAPscript → device type SWIN/SAPWIN → spool administration → cab label printer


### **Smart Forms**

 Method 1: Integration of cab JScript in a Smart Forms report. Device type is LB\_CAB, "passing through" the data from the Smart Forms report.

Smart Forms incl. JScript → device type LB\_CAB → spool administration → cab label printer

 Method 2: Device type SWIN/SAPWIN in connection with SAPSprint and Windows driver

Smart Forms → device type SWIN/SAPWIN → spool administration → cab label printer

### **Adobe Interactive Forms**

This solution uses Adobe® software integrated in the SAP® system. Interactive forms can be generated in PDF format.

Upon receipt of the PDF the SAP® system extracts the data stored in the form for further processing. Output is done via the SAPPDFPRINT (→ http://bit.ly/1eBUwa2) service and the Windows driver.
